ABERDOUR CASTLE

CEREMONIES & PHOTOGRAPHY

In a beautiful location overlooking the Forth Estuary, Aberdour Castle boasts a delightful walled garden with ornate terraces and an unusual beehive-shaped dovecot.

This impressive property is a 12th century fortified residence which was extended by the Douglases over hundreds of years. Incorporating splendid features such as a fine painted ceiling, the castle provides a gracious setting for wedding ceremonies. The castle gardens are a perennial favourite for wedding photography.

Location

In Aberdour, Fife, eight miles east of the Forth Bridges on the A921. Postcode: KY3 0SL

Venues

Long Gallery: Located on the first floor of the castle, this elegant room has fine reproduction furniture. A charming adjacent room may be used to sign the register.

Capacity: 60 people.

Facilities

60 chairs, a red carpet, two tables with tablecloths, a table top lectern, a battery powered CD/USB/SD audio player, LED candles and two cast iron flower stands are available.

Additional Information

Candles are not permitted at this site. Car parking is available for guests at the train station a short walk from the castle. Stretch limousines are not permitted. The long gallery does not have heating due to the sensitive nature of the architecture. Weddings may not take place earlier than 1pm, or later than 2pm from October to March.
