

DUFF HOUSE

Ceremonies, & Photography

Celebrate your wedding ceremony and reception at Duff House, a splendid baroque mansion designed and built in the 18th century by William Adam.

The striking classical gilt interiors create a romantic and elegant atmosphere. The house contains masterpieces on loan from the National Galleries of Scotland, including paintings by El Greco, Gainsborough, Ramsay and Raeburn.

For over 100 years couples have married in this grand country house, formerly home to the Earls of Fife and even to a Royal Princess, when in 1889 the 6th Earl married HRH Princess Louise, the eldest granddaughter of Queen Victoria.

Location

Near Banff just off the A98. Postcode: AB45 3SX.

Venues

Salon: This grand room is hung with 18th century tapestries and contains furniture made by Thomas Chippendale. It is ideal for your ceremony. Capacity: 80 (seated)

North Drawing Room: The tranquil atmosphere of the North Drawing Room makes it ideally suited for a more intimate wedding ceremony. Capacity: 25 (seated).

Additional Information

There is a lift with access to each of the floors and all venues are wheelchair accessible. Candles are not permitted in the house.
