Melrose Abbey is a magnificent ruin on a grand scale. The Abbey is thought to be the burial place of Robert the Bruce's heart, marked with a carved stone plaque within the grounds.

### Location

In Melrose off the A7 or A68.  
Postcode: TD6 9LG

### Venues

#### Presbytery area of the Church (partially open air):

An imposing magnificent building with lavishly decorated stone work.  
Capacity: 60 seated and 40 standing  
or 100 standing.

#### The Garth of the Cloister (open air):

A large grassed area located to the left of Presbytery area of the church.  
Capacity: 100 standing.

### Facilities

60 chairs, two tables with tablecloths, a table top lectern, a battery powered CD/USB/SD audio player.
