

Huntingtower Castle

CEREMONIES & PHOTOGRAPHY

Once known as The House of Ruthven, Huntingtower Castle was a lordly residence for over 300 years and was associated with two noble families – the Ruthvens and the Murrays.

Comprising two fine and complete tower houses, built just three metres apart in the 15th and 16th centuries and joined in later years, the castle's eastern tower has a striking hall with a splendid painted ceiling and walls.

Huntingtower has in its time hosted some famous visitors, and been linked with dramatic events, but it is perhaps best remembered romantically as the honeymoon destination of Mary Queen of Scots and Lord Darnley.

Location

Two miles west of Perth off the A85 Crieff Road. Postcode: PH1 3JL

Venues

State Room: Located in the West Tower, this impressive room dates back to around 1500. Capacity: 60 people.

Facilities

60 chairs, a red carpet, two tables with tablecloths, a table top lectern, a battery powered CD/USB/SD audio player, LED candles and two cast iron flower stands are available.

Additional Information

Candles are not permitted at Huntingtower Castle. The castle has no heating due to the sensitive nature of its architecture. There is limited parking at the castle.
