SETON COLLEGIATE CHURCH

CEREMONIES & PHOTOGRAPHY

Seton Collegiate Church is an impressive building with a welcoming atmosphere. The transepts, choir and sacristy are in good condition and full offascinating detail, from the possible tomb of the Second Lord Seton to the cracked Dutch Bell hung in the tower from 1577 and now on show.

Set in exceptional grounds the Church gardens are a beautiful backdrop for your wedding photography.

Location

One mile south east of Cockenzie off the A198. Postcode: EH32 0PG

Venue

The Choir: The principal area of the Church boasts an impressive vaulted ceiling and lots of natural daylight.

Capacity: 100 people (80 seated with 20 standing)

Facilities

80 chairs, a red carpet, two tables with tablecloths, a table top lectern, a battery powered CD/USB/SD audio player, electric candles and two cast Iron flower stands are available.

Additional Information

Candles are not permitted at this site.

Access to the Church is via the footpath from the public car park. Please note that guests must access the Church using this route.
