CEREMONIES & PHOTOGRAPHY

Unique among Scottish Castles for both its early date and unusual circular plan, Rothesay Castle had a long and close association with the Stuart Kings of Scotland.

Today, the dramatic moat and impressive gatehouse are just some of the features that make it such a special setting for wedding ceremonies and photography.

Location

In Rothesay, Isle of Bute, ferry from Wemyss Bay on the A78.
Postcode: PA20 0DA

Venues

Great Hall: Located on the first floor, this hall boasts original features as it was the principle chamber in the castle.

Capacity: 100 (80 standing with 20 seated) or 60 (all seated)

Chapel: A small, intimate and romantic space. Capacity: 60 (all standing) or 40 (all seated)

Courtyard: A stunning, open air space. Capacity: 100 (60 standing with 40 seated) or 60 (all seated)

Facilities

60 chairs, a red carpet, two tables with tablecloths, a table top lectern, a battery powered CD/USB/SD audio player, electric candles and two cast iron flower stands are available.

Additional Information

Candles are not permitted at this site. Wheelchair access is restricted to the chapel and courtyard.
