

CAERLAVEROCK CASTLE

Ceremonies & Photography

With its moat, twin-towered gatehouse and lofty battlements, Caerlaverock Castle is the epitome of a medieval stronghold.

A formidable and impressive fortress, the castle looks as though it could have risen out of the pages of a story book about knights and dragons – there could hardly be a better fairytale setting for wedding ceremonies.

One of Scotland's finest heritage attractions, this imposing castle stands guard over the Solway Firth, and its unique architecture and superb location makes it a stunning backdrop for wedding photography.

Location

Eight miles south-east of Dumfries on the B725. Postcode: DG1 4RU

Venues

Great Hall: This open air venue is situated on the ground floor of the castle's south range, overlooking the moat and the nature reserve. Capacity: 60 people.

Facilities

A table, with table cloth and table top lectern and battery powered CD/USB/SD audio player are available.

Additional Information

Candles are not permitted at this site. The castle is wheelchair accessible but wedding party assessment is recommended.
